



## TERMS & CONDITIONS for BUSINESS MEMBERSHIP

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Business Member of Orange F.O.O.D Week. The following information outlines the requirements to become a Business Member of F.O.O.D Week Inc.

### ELIGIBILITY

Membership is not guaranteed. To be eligible for membership;

- *Business members must have their business domiciled in Orange, Cabonne or Blayney Council local government areas.*
- *All applicants must check the box or sign the membership form at time of payment to acknowledge their acceptance of the association's membership requirements.*

Once your membership is accepted and if you choose to become a stallholder at a community event OR hold an event during F.O.O.D Week you **must offer food or showcase principal ingredients that are grown or produced within the food of Orange district i.e. Orange, Cabonne or Blayney Local Government Areas (LGA)**. If you are unsure if your product will meet this essential criteria or if you fall within these LGA's please do not hesitate to contact anyone from the F.O.O.D Week Committee. Over the years F.O.O.D Week has been commended for being an authentic food festival - one that is truly committed to showcasing locally grown produce. Such regard can only be achieved if we continue to work together on this important aspect.

If your business membership is accepted you must AGREE at all times to up hold the F.O.O.D Week Inc. charter, act in a professional manner and be bound by the terms and conditions set out by the organisation for community events.

The principal idea of F.O.O.D Week is to showcase the region's diversity of quality products and produce, where it comes from, how to cook it and where to buy it. As such **every stall at the Night Market, Food Affair or Forage MUST feature local food, produce or wine.**
